April 6th 1865

Mr Lincoln has been in Richmond, near half the City has been destroyed by fire by the Rebels themselves as they evacuated it, Large numbers of prisoners have been captured by Sheridan, Gen Excell and his Corps. some seven thousand.

April 9th

Gen Lee has surrendered to Gen Grant with his whole Army!
Mr Lincoln has returned to Washington as Mr Sumner at the prospect of a speedy peace. It is thought that Johnson and the other rebel Gen's will give up now that Lee has surrendered.

April 14th 1/2 past 10 o'clock
Of fatal day. O noble victim
Treason has done its worst.
The President has been assassinated!
It has just been announced at my door that he was shot a half hour ago at Ford's Theatre. Is it possible?
