Title: Study Rooms

Operational Procedure - Date Adopted by the EHRA Assembly: April 3, 1997

Date Revised: October 29, 2009; May 17, 2012; December 17, 2015; January 9, 2020

Study rooms are available to patrons in Joyner Library. Study rooms are designated as either small or group study rooms. Small study rooms are generally intended for use by 1-2 people and group study rooms are generally intended for use by 3-10 people.

Most study rooms may be reserved by ECU affiliated patrons for a designated period. Details concerning the reservation process are found on the library's web page.

When not reserved, study rooms are available to patrons on a first-come, first-serve basis with the exceptions of those study rooms for designated users. Rooms may occasionally become unavailable due to special events or building maintenance needs. At any time there may be occasional brief interruptions for Housekeeping staff to perform various tasks as needed.

Library Administration may designate some study rooms for exclusive use by specific East Carolina University populations (e.g. The Honors College, graduate students, and Project STEPP). Designated rooms are clearly marked by signage. Patrons who may use these designated rooms must currently be enrolled in the specified program or have the appropriate classification at ECU.
